Report Name	Description	Comments	Comparable Standard BANCAP/ <i>CHASER</i> /NIBS Reports
Cases	Captures activity by date/date range. Displays case number, file date, asset designation, fee status, chapter, county, discharged, dismissed or converted date, judge, trustee. Sort options include office, judge, trustee, type and chapter. Includes an option to include debtor's SSN and address. Can be run by terminal digit.	Used to monitor new bankruptcy and adversary filings. Can be used as report for cases discharged, closed, dismissed or converted. This report is available to external users through standard PACER access.	BANCAP Daily Filings, Pending Cases, Closed Cases reports, NIBS Filing/Termination report.
Claims Register	Claims activity by date, or claim number. Extensive fields from standard claims form for description and classification.	Status (reclassified, disallowed, withdrawn, expunged, etc.) can be updated by docketing. Hyperlink to docket sheet, claim and any related attachments. This report is available to external users via PACER.	BANCAP Claims Register, NIBS Claims Register, PACER Claims Register
Docket Report	Official case information with caption and docket entries by file or EOD date. Options for links to copy of notice of electronic filing and/or terminated parties.	The docket report available to the public will not include private court events. One can restrict activity by date, document or display recent activity at the top of the report to reduce PACER costs. Calendar Events	Most powerful of CM/ECF calendars used for hearing settings only (not deadlines). Usually made available to trustees and attorney other and PACER users. Can be restricted to specific types of hearings. Options for full docket text, supplemental display of all related filings. Practical tool for §341 Meeting Calendar.	Can be extensively customized by court's calendar events. Able to use html coding to modify appearance of text, can create report headers. Can save 3 most recent reports per judge, per day, per division, per user. This report can record courtroom deputy and/or court reporter designation.	BANCAP Hearings Calendar, 341 Meetings report, NIBS Calendars
Mailing Labels	Mailing labels by case are available to court users under the Utilities menu and found within Mailings. Names and addresses of all entities on the case and the creditor list and special mailing groups are available. Labels can be produced by a variety of criteria including party role, creditor type.	Case number is required. Web functionality does allow a 3 column display for labels .	BANCAP label programs.
