FILING PERIODIC FINANCIAL REPORTS

Effective upon entry of this order, and pending formal amendment of Local Bankruptcy Rule 2015-2,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Local Bankruptcy Rule 2015-2 is supplanted by the following:

Rule 2015-2. Periodic Financial Reports Filed with the United States Trustee.

Periodic financial reports required to be filed by a trustee, a debtor in possession, or a chapter 13 debtor engaged in business, including but not limited to those described in 11 U.S.C. §§ 308(b), 704(a)(8), 1106(a)(7), 1202(b)(5), 1203, and 1304(c), and Fed.Rs.Bankr.P. 2015(a) and 2015.3, shall be filed *only* with the United States Trustee, but shall be deemed filed with the Court when filed with the United States Trustee. If any such periodic financial reports are mistakenly sent to the Court, the Clerk shall forward them to the United States Trustee.
