GENERAL ORDER EXTENDING
INTERIM FED.R.BANKR.P. 1007-I

IT APPEARING the National Guard and Reservist Debt Relief Extension Act of 2011, Pub.L. 112-64, has extended for an additional four years the temporary exclusion from the bankruptcy means test for certain Reservists and members of the National Guard provided by the National Guard and Reservists Debt Relief Act of 2008, Pub.L. 110-438, which was implemented by Interim Fed.R.Bankr.P. 1007-I, adopted in this District by general order entered December 19, 2008, and amended by general orders entered November 30, 2009, and November 8, 2010; and for cause shown; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED Interim Fed.R.Bankr.P. 1007-I, adopted in this District by general order entered December 19, 2008, and amended by general orders entered November 30, 2009, and November 8, 2010, is extended for an additional four years to apply to all cases filed in the District of South Dakota on or after December 19, 2008, and for the seven-year period thereafter expiring December 18, 2015. All other provisions of the general orders entered December 19, 2008, November 30, 2009, and November 8, 2010, remain in effect.
