GENERAL ORDER REGARDING FILING OF CLAIMS
THROUGH ELECTRONIC PROOF OF CLAIM SYSTEM

IT APPEARING the Court has implemented the Electronic Proof of Claim (ePOC) system for the filing of claims; now, therefore,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED filing a claim electronically through ePOC shall constitute the signature of the filer for all purposes with respect to the claim, pursuant to Section V.A. of the Court's Electronic Case Filing Administrative Procedures, and shall have the same force and effect as if the filer signed a paper copy of the claim.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED a claim filed through ePOC shall state the name and title, if any, of the filer and shall contain an "/s/" with the name of the filer typed in the location where the signature would otherwise appear.
