Last month 57 bankruptcy cases were filed in South Dakota, the same number filed in the first month of 2016.

Electronic Notice to Debtors

Please consider registering your debtor clients to receive electronic notice of all filings in their cases. If a debtor has an e-mail account and Adobe Reader and completes and signs a Debtor's Request to Receive Electronic Notice, you can e-file the completed form using the CM/ECF event "Electronic Notice Registration (Debtor)" found under Bankruptcy - Other. After the form is e-filed, the debtor will receive e-notice of all filings in the case and you, creditors, and the Court will no longer be required to mail hard copies of filed documents to the debtor.
