Chapter 13 Plan Follow-up Seminars

Today - Monday, April 23 - a special seminar by Chapter 13 Trustee Dale Wein and Judge Nail's law clerk, Kay Cee Hodson, will be held in Aberdeen regarding the district's local chapter 13 plan form. Pursuant to Bank. D.S.D. R. 2002-4(c), if a valid address for a creditor cannot be determined, the recipient of returned mail or a notice of returned or undeliverable mail shall file a statement

conforming to [Appendix 2K](#) (Debtor's Statement Regarding Certain Undeliverable or Returned Mail) that lists the name of the person or entity not served, references each address at which service was attempted but not made, identifies each document for which good service has not been made, and summarizes the resources used to attempt to obtain a good address. When electronically filing a Debtor's Statement Regarding Certain Undeliverable or Returned Mail, please use the CM/ECF event "Statement re: Undeliverable or Returned Mail" found under Bankruptcy - Other.

Filing this statement does **not** excuse or substitute for good service. It just provides a clearer record of the service attempts made.
