South Dakota Filings Up 3 Percent in 2018

In the first nine months of this year South Dakota bankruptcy filings increased three percent from the number of bankruptcies filed in the first three-quarters of 2017.

Mail Returned or Identified as Undeliverable

When a notice or other document is served by mail by counsel for a debtor, it may be returned to the debtor's counsel as undeliverable by the postal service. When a notice or other document is served through the Bankruptcy Noticing Center and is unable to be delivered, the BNC e-mails a Notice of Returned Mail to counsel for the debtor attaching the undelivered document and stating the name and address of the intended recipient. Please do not ignore returned mail or mail identified as undeliverable. If the record does not show a creditor received key notices in a case, the creditor's claim is presumed not to be discharged.

When a mailed notice or other document is returned to counsel for a debtor or a creditor's address has been identified as undeliverable, counsel for the debtor should make a reasonable effort to determine the correct address for the intended recipient, re-serve the undelivered notice or other document at the party's correct address, and prepare and file a Certificate of Service Regarding Returned or Undeliverable Mail conforming to Appendix 2J of our local rules, as required by Bankr. D.S.D. R. 2002-4(a). When filing a Certificate of Service Regarding Returned or Undeliverable Mail, please use the CM/ECF event "Certificate of Service" found under Bankruptcy - Other.

Pursuant to Bankr. D.S.D. R. 2002-4(c), if a valid address for a party cannot be determined, counsel for the debtor should prepare and file a Debtor's Statement Regarding Certain Undeliverable or Returned Mail conforming to Appendix 2K of our local rules that lists the name of the party not served, references each address at which service was attempted but not made, identifies each document for which good service has not been made, and summarizes the resources used to attempt to obtain a good address for the party. When filing a Debtor's Statement Regarding Certain Undeliverable or Returned Mail, please use the CM/ECF event "Statement re: Undeliverable or Returned Mail" found under Bankruptcy - Other.
