Joint Debtors and Sole Proprietorships

Counsel for debtors, please do **not** list a particular business as a dba or an fdba for both joint debtors. As stated in the Practice Pointers following Bankr. D.S.D. R. 1002-1:

If a married couple files a joint petition, only one joint debtor should be reflected on the petition as previously or presently operating a particular business as a sole proprietorship. If both joint debtors are associated with the same business, it indicates the couple operated the business as a partnership, not a sole proprietorship. However, a partnership is a legal entity that must file a separate petition to obtain bankruptcy relief.
