Telephonic Hearings and Speakerphones

To allow Judge Nail and other parties to be heard at all times during telephonic hearings and conference calls, attorneys and other parties should only speak using a telephone handset or a full-duplex (**not** a half-duplex) speakerphone. A half-duplex speakerphone is similar to a walkie-talkie in that when the user of the system is talking no one else on the call can be heard by the speaker or by the other participants. In contrast, a full-duplex speakerphone allows the speaker and everyone else on the call to speak and be heard at all times. If you are using a half-duplex speakerphone to participate in a telephonic hearing or a conference call and wish to speak, please pick up your handset and speak using it (a handset is a full-duplex device). If you don't know whether your speakerphone is full-duplex or half-duplex, please check with your telephone provider.
