Attorneys Must Have Possession of Signed Original Document Before Filing It in CM/ECF

Pursuant to our <u>Electronic Case Filing Administrative Procedures</u>, Part V.B., an attorney must have possession of the fully signed original document at the time the attorney electronically files it in CM/ECF. If, for example, a change to a proposed Plan as Confirmed is necessary, make the change and then get a new signature and date from each debtor on the revised Plan as Confirmed before filing it. A party signing a document should review and sign the exact document that will be filed.
