Temporary Local Rule Establishing Procedure for Obtaining a Discharge Under 11 U.S.C. § 1328(i)

Last week Judge Nail issued a <u>General Order</u> establishing a temporary local bankruptcy rule setting forth a procedure for obtaining a discharge under 11 U.S.C. § 1328(i). This new subsection was created by the Consolidated Appropriations Act of 2021 and allows a debtor who has not completed payments to the trustee or a creditor holding a security interest in the principal residence of the debtor to obtain a discharge under certain circumstances. Temporary local bankruptcy rule 3072-1C will remain effective through December 27, 2021, when § 1328(i) sunsets.
