## **U.S. Trustee Program to Post Revised Monthly Operating and Post-confirmation Report Forms**

Jim Snyder, the Acting United States Trustee for Region 12, has asked us to pass along the following message:

Effective June 21, 2021, 28 C.F.R. § 58.8 required chapter 11 debtors-in-possession and trustees, other than in small business and subchapter V cases, to file monthly operating reports (MORs) and post-confirmation reports (PCRs) using uniform data-embedded forms. The original forms had some conflicts with Adobe and the Court's CM/ECF system. Resolving those issues required the creation of new forms. On November 30, 2021, the United States Trustee Program (USTP) will post the updated versions of the forms on its website. These new forms should be used for all reports filed beginning in December 2021.

The new forms are designed to improve the overall user experience. The updates will streamline the process of embedding data on the forms by using standard PDF bar-code technology. The updates do not impact the information required to be reported on the MORs and the PCRs.
