Post-Petition Financial Management Course

After an individual debtor completes the required post-petition financial management course, either the counseling agency must electronically file the Certificate of Debtor Education or the debtor must sign and date a Certification About a Financial Management Course (Official Form 423), which the debtor's attorney shall then electronically file. Because neither the debtor nor the debtor's attorney signs the Certificate of Debtor Education provided by the counseling agency, the debtor's attorney must **not** electronically file it.
