## **E-Notice Without Filing a Notice of Appearance**

If you wish to receive electronic notice in a bankruptcy case or an adversary proceeding, but don't want to file a notice of appearance, you may do so but it'll cost you. In CM/ECF, go to "Utilities," then "Maintain Your ECF Account," then "Email information...," then check the "Send notices in these additional cases" box and type in the case number of any bankruptcy case

or adversary proceeding. You won't get the "one free look" given to a filer of a notice of appearance, but will be charged the standard PACER rate to view documents and pleadings in these additional cases.
