South Dakota Filings Up Four Percent in 2026

In the first two months of 2026 South Dakota bankruptcy filings increased by four percent from the number of bankruptcies filed in the first two months of last year.

Correcting a Debtor's Social Security Number

As required by Bankr. D.S.D. R. 1009-3, if a debtor needs to correct a Social Security Number that was either electronically uploaded with a petition or set forth in a Statement About Your Social Security Numbers (Official Form 121), the debtor must file and serve a combined amendment and notice of amendment that conforms to Appendix 1K of our local bankruptcy rules. The amendment must specifically state the change being made and, in the case of joint debtors, identify the debtor whose Social Security Number is being corrected. When filing this amendment and notice of amendment, use the CM/ECF event "Amendment of Social Security Number with Notice" found under Bankruptcy - Other. This event is restricted and can only be viewed by court users.
