Deadline to File Motions to Reschedule Hearings or Documents to Resolve Hearings in Sioux Falls

For regularly scheduled non-evidentiary hearings in Sioux Falls, the deadline to file a motion to reschedule a hearing or to file or withdraw a document to resolve a matter and cancel a hearing is **at least 48 hours prior to the time of the scheduled hearing**. If such a motion or document is filed or withdrawn after this deadline, the motion may be denied or the document may not be approved, and the hearing may be held as scheduled with all attorneys involved in the matter required to appear in person.

Deadline to File Motions to Reschedule Hearings or Documents to Resolve Hearings in Aberdeen, Pierre, and Rapid City

When Judge Kulm Ask travels to Aberdeen, Pierre, or Rapid City for regularly scheduled non-evidentiary hearings, the deadline to file a motion to reschedule a hearing or to file or withdraw a document to resolve a matter and cancel a hearing is 12:00 noon on the Monday of the week of the hearing. For example, if hearings are scheduled for Rapid City on Thursday, April 23, the deadline is 12:00 noon (Mountain Time) on Monday, April 20. If such a motion or document is filed or withdrawn after this deadline, the motion may be denied or the document may not be approved, and the hearing may be held as scheduled with all attorneys involved in the matter required to appear in person.
