chapter 11 cases and any related adversary proceedings to the Hon. Kesha L. Tanabe;


chapter 12 cases and any related adversary proceedings to the Hon. Shon Hastings; and

chapter 13 cases with a terminal case number digit of 0, 2, 4, 6, and 8 and any related adversary proceedings to the Hon. Shon Hastings and chapter 13 cases with a terminal case number digit of 1, 3, 5, 7, and 9 and any related adversary proceedings to the Hon. Kesha L. Tanabe.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED the venue of said cases and adversary proceedings will remain unchanged, all pleadings in said cases and adversary proceedings shall continue to be filed with the Bankruptcy Clerk for the District of South Dakota, and Shan Stroup, Scheduling Deputy Clerk, will coordinate the scheduling of all hearings, trials, and conferences for Judge Hastings and Judge Tanabe in said cases.
